**Call meeting to order:** M.Scarborough- 6:35pm

**Approval of Minutes:** Scarborough, Weiss seconds. All approve

**President's Report:** Fall sports now complete. Football has 2 league champs. Now moving on to winter sports. The district is moving forward with lighting for fields, waiting on biologist report.

**Treasurer's Report:** As of today total bank balance is \$355K, with month end October at \$347. . The first two months of our fiscal year spent ~\$50k. The end of October bingo has lost ~\$9K. However we did spend \$55K in bingo cards so have money in cards.

Scarborough makes a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report. Rowe seconds. All approve.

**Current Funds Requests:**

- Football
  - Game Day Headsets. Football has insufficient funds.
  - Patches will be between \$800-\$900 for league Champs
  - Plaques/awards approximately \$500 per team.
  - Team shirts
  - Will hold on Dave Maze engraving for this year

Discussion was had that we need to save the football snack shack for buses as invoices have not come in and we need to be proactive in keeping money for next year. Weisse will go through the square sales and be pulling money from shirt fundraiser to go into football account. Rowe stated that JV football and Varsity football are allotted \$150 per team for team awards.

M Scarborough requested that football not purchase more items prior to checking with boosters since there are insufficient funds in the football account.

M Scarborough makes a motion to approve for patches to be 50% booster, 50% football account. All other items will come out of football account. Football account will go further in the negative. Weisse seconds M Scarborough motion for fund allocation.

- Athletic Supplies for Trainer
  - \$2186.51 for misc suppliers (tape, bandages, gatorade, etc)

M Scarborough makes a motion to approve. Rowe Seconds

- Gym Door Sign
  - Request was made for boosters to purchase a sign notifying people to use the main door for games. Boosters discussion was had that ASB collects the door funds and should be purchasing door sign.

M Scarborough makes a motion to not approve door sign and notify ASB they should be purchasing sign since they collect funds. All approve.

- Girls Basketball
  - New basketballs at ~1k.

M Scarborough makes a motion for girls basketball to deplete account and boosters to pay the rest. All approve.

- Boys Soccer
  - Baltezar submitted information about e-sports that he may pursue further off season for players to keep stats
  - Soccer will need rain jackets which will be ~\$100 per jacket. Boys soccer has sufficient funds in account so no need to bring to boosters.
- Wrestling
  - Tournaments will be ~\$2000 +/- . ASB has been submitted for initial tournaments. They are beginning fundraising. Request to bring back to boosters when they run out of ASB funds to see status of fundraising if additional funds are needed.
  - Likely will have 3 kids going to state this year and will need funds as it will be an out of area few days tournament.

#### **Old Business:**

- Department of Justice. Boosters is in good standing for 2025. 2026 submitted.

#### **New Business:**

- Taxes/Accountant
  - 2025 taxes have been turned in. Monitoring status for new tax submissions to ensure we are timely.
- Bingo Status

- Bingo continues to be not making a profit. Boosters is actively looking at each weeks deposits to make a decision if bingo will be sustainable. Meeting with Hill was had a few weeks ago to be in alignment with bingo status.
