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SLV Athletic Boosters Meeting Minutes

Approval of Minutes: McIntyre approves. Sizemore seconds. All approve

Treasurer's Report: The April 30th month end reports were distributed in the meeting: Statement of Activity 9/1/2025-4/30/2026, SLV Booster Summary of Team accounts month end April 2026.

Additional itemized reports were provided for girls volleyball, boys volleyball, girls basketball and boys basketball showing the purchases through boosters for the past couple of years. This is to be utilized by new coaches to understand when jerseys were last purchased and an understanding of what is typically needed for fundraising for the season.

When reviewing reports, Boosters requests all coaches to get a system in place for uniform disbursement and retrieval to ensure the uniforms are returned at the end of the season. Sizemore indicated that the previous athletic director would capture this information and withhold diplomas if seniors did not return jerseys.

Agenda Items:

- Costa requested boosters to reimburse for an invoice of approximate \$150 for a plyometrics box for the weight room. There was a recent generic donation to boosters that will cover this cost. McIntyre makes a motion to approve. Rowe second. All approve.

- Costa requested for new equipment for sports teams and potentially PE for the weight room that is estimated to be \$4,000. Boosters recommended that he reach out to each coach of teams that will utilize the equipment as well as the school for PE for a cost sharing plan. Boosters is happy to be a contributor but will need teams and the school to also contribute. anonymously for fair review and ranked them. The top three scores were approved to receive the scholarships. Sizemore to notify the school.
- Varsity Letters
 - Football purchased varsity letters for \$587. Previously boosters paid for these costs but the athletic director was in charge of letters since each player gets one letter for their first varsity sport and not for each individual sport. McIntyre makes a motion we pay the invoice but notify both the Athletic Director and Grant that future purchases should be handed through the Athletic Director.
- Fundraising ideas
 - Discussion was had with the Athletic Director surrounding a need for each team to be considered individually. A budget needs to be put together for each team to determine what the needs are for the sport prior to the season. From there they can review what the teams fundraising activities are. A team may or may not need the \$200 donation per player if the fundraising plans are expected to meet the needs of their budget. This planning should be shared in the parent meeting
 - Boosters discussed doing a community bingo event with a trial run like in September. This will be more community based than being an avid bingo player. Doing it in September will allow for parents to get settled into the school year prior to doing. Felton community center is a lower cost venue that has a 25% discount for non-profits.
